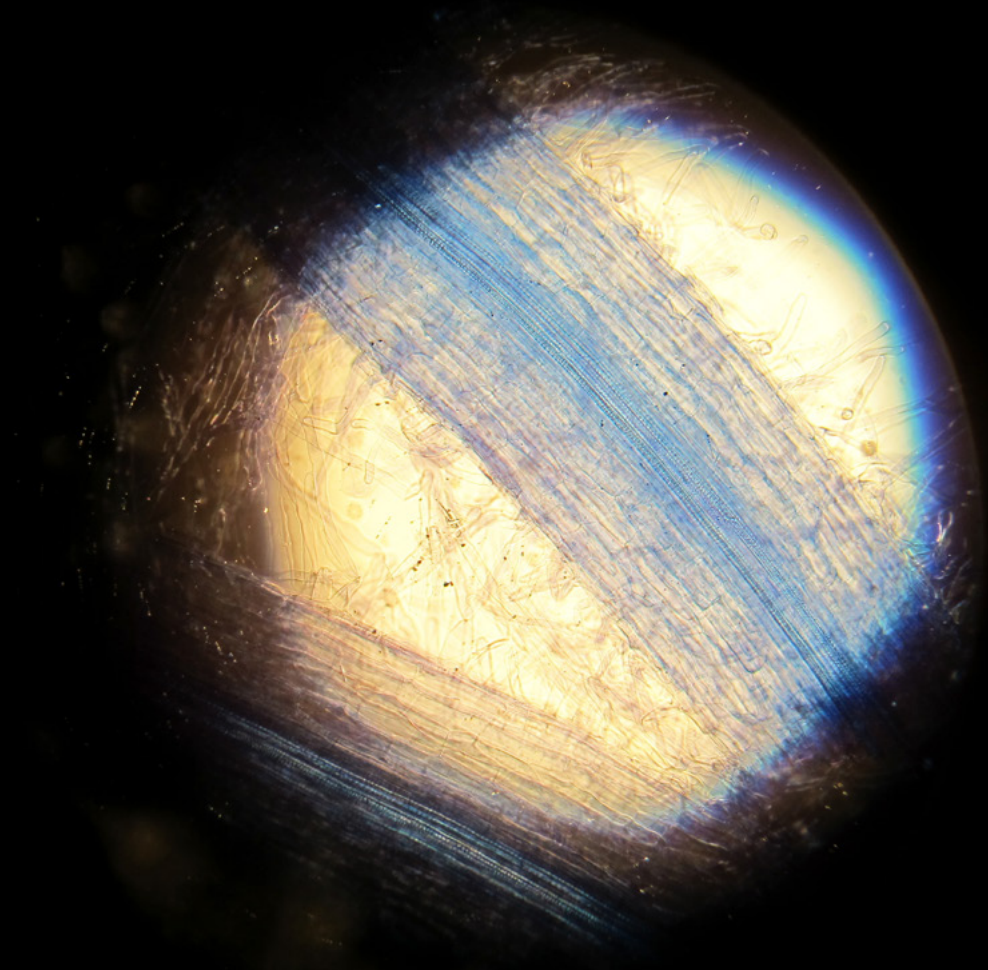
"Think of something like the Libor rigging, where

very significant." TLP

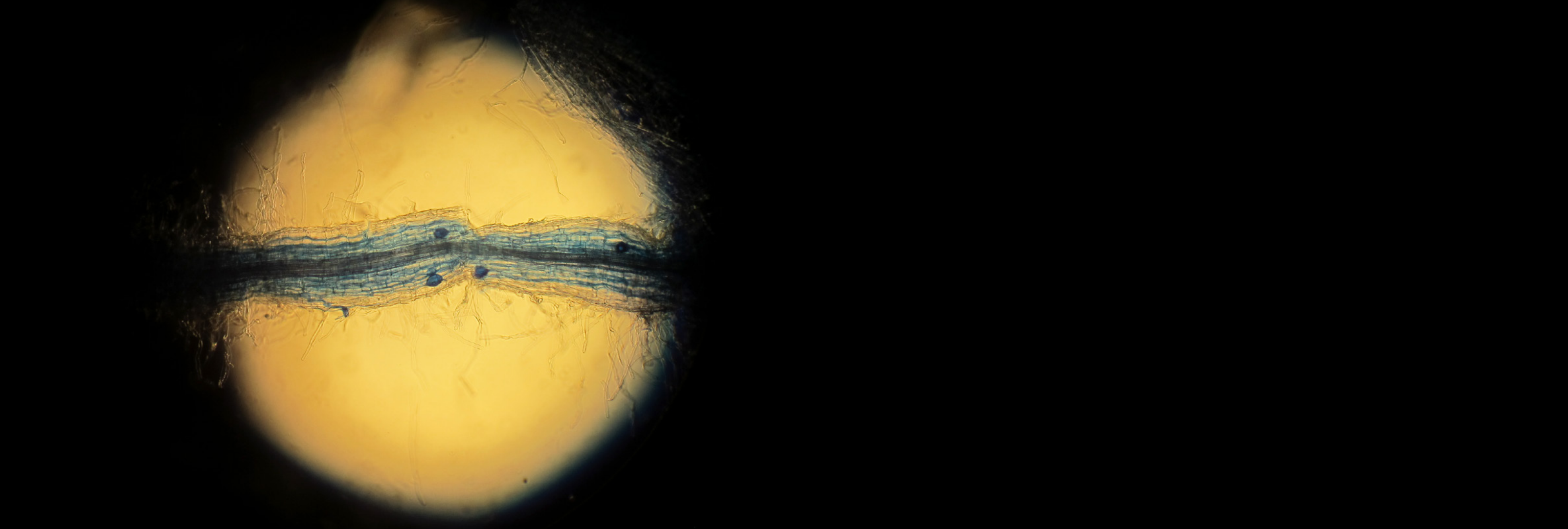

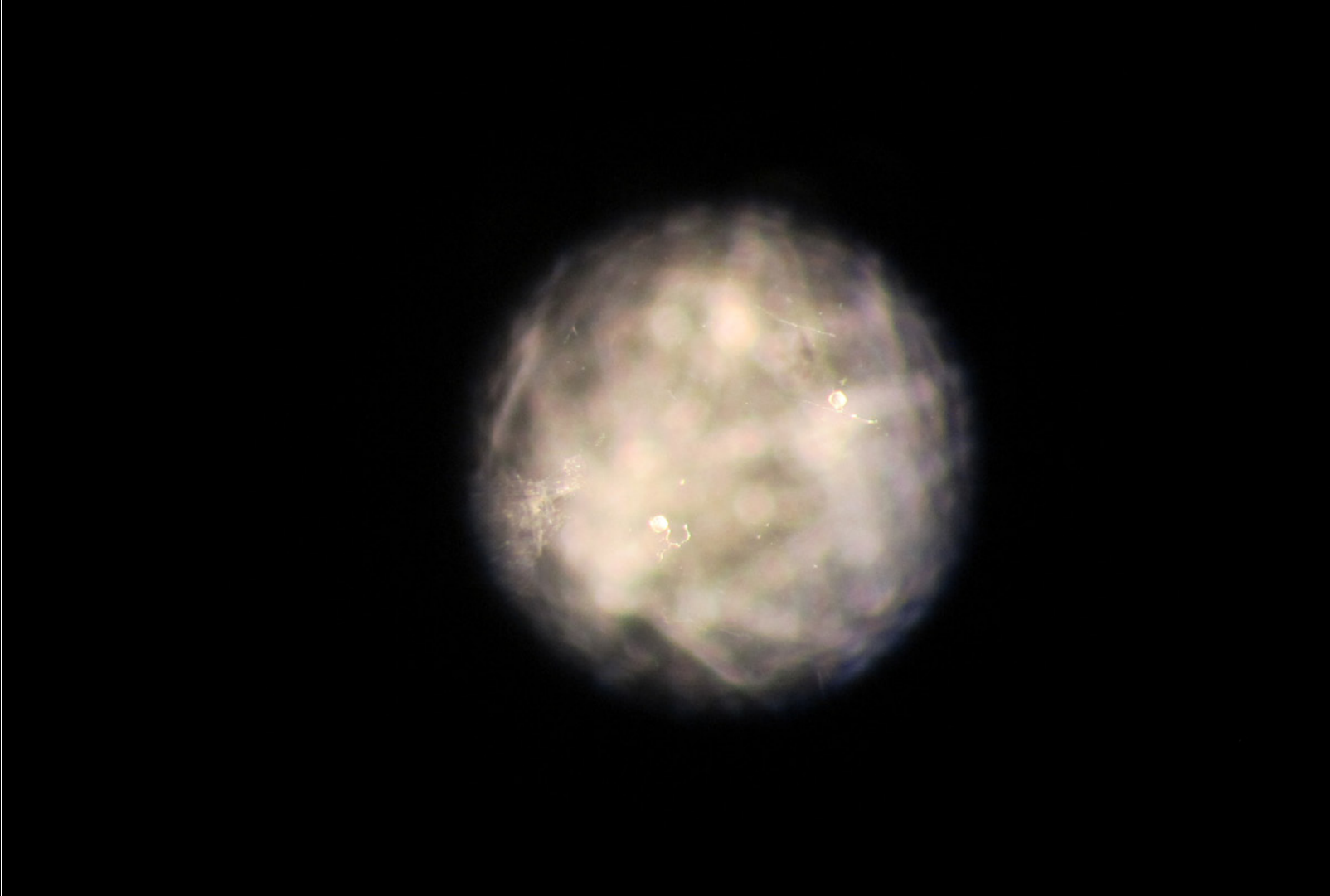
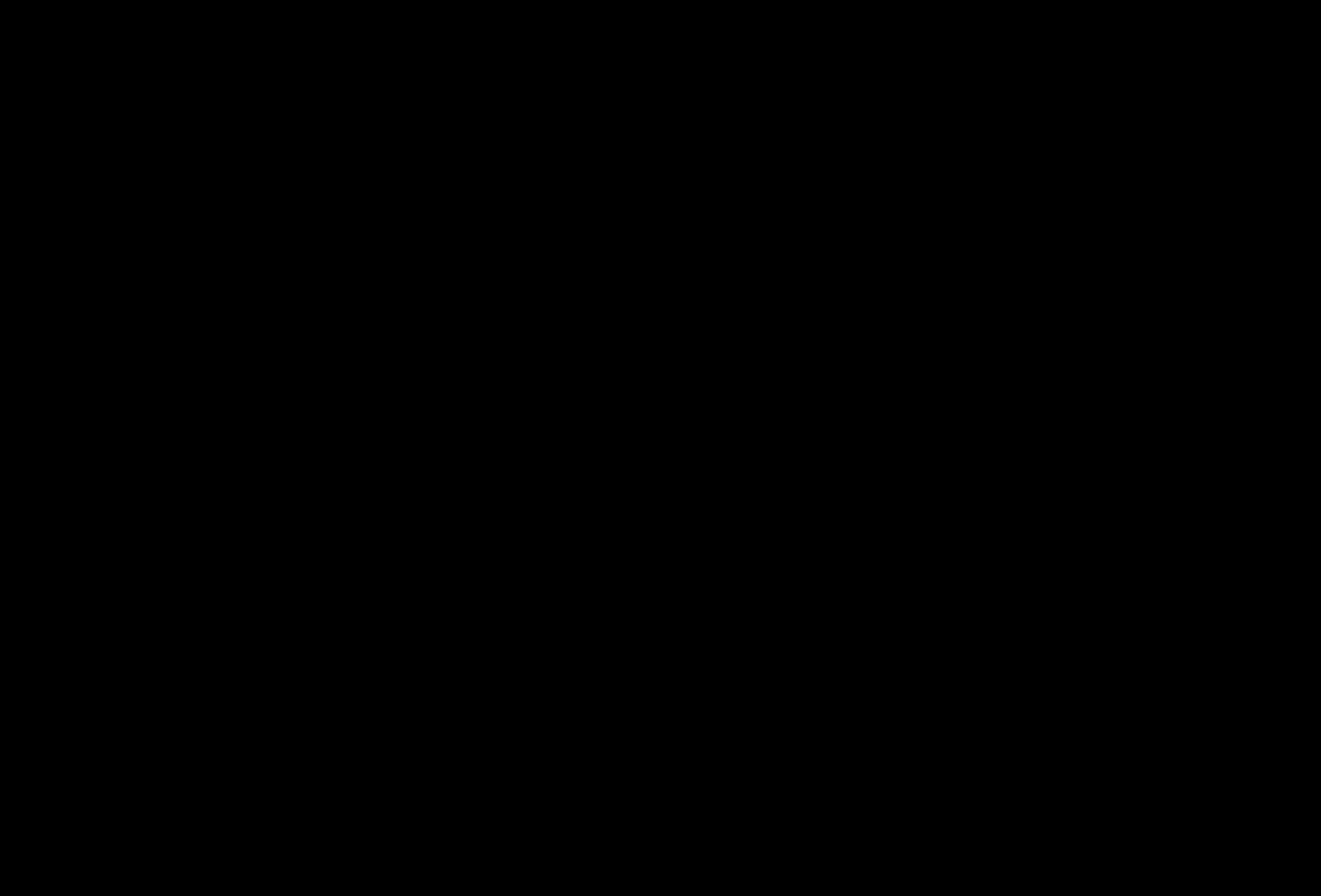
